We are working on getting contribution envelopes sent to you very soon along with more information about these changes. We appreciate your faithfulness in giving and praying for us as we serve the Lord in Belize.

For the first time in fourteen years we are really struggling with taking time off for furlough. Late last year we were able to start a new church in the Training Center main building. We are averaging 35-40 people on Sunday mornings. We recently had a young man, Elvis Lara, come on board to lead us in worship before Bob preaches. We have continued to have the Friday night youth meetings at the Training Center with about 30 in attendance. Twelve of those students were rewarded with a special trip to Placencia (beach) for being outstanding in scripture memory, attendance, and class participation. We will be starting a doctrine class for the top ten in the youth group this summer. We are calling this thirteen week study course "Cycle One."

In March we baptized six people and have had several salvations since then. Bob

was able to pray with a lady, Elsa, to receive Christ recently. She is pregnant and due in a couple of months— please keep her in your prayers. Rhonda is now discipling Miss Bridget once per week and Bob is meeting with a new convert by the name of Rene (a painter in our area) weekly as well. It is so exciting to see God at work around us! The Training Center is very near completion with only some interior doors still needed for the kitchen and large conference area. We are now living in the new residence even though it is not quite completed. We have yet to build or purchase kitchen cabinets/sink and island as well as a few bi-fold doors for bathrooms and closets. We'll still share the Training Center kitchen until this stage is done. But, it feels so nice to have a home! The containers have been removed from the T/C yard and a new rain water catchment tank is complete.

We have had several visitors this quarter. A mission team from Oak Hills Community Church in Floresville spent a week on Ambergris Caye working to plant a new church there. Mike Warren from Athens, Texas, visited Bob and they discussed plans to build a new 60' X 100' agricultural barn for growing vegetables, livestock, and also to house the ministry work shop.
